

## **FAQ: Nissan \$3,000 LEAF Purchase Incentive Program**

**Overview:** As part of the effort to accelerate clean transportation alternatives in California, PG&E customers and employees are now eligible for a special incentive of \$3,000 off the manufacturer suggested retail price (MSRP) on the purchase of a new 2018 Nissan LEAF, which is an all-electric vehicle.

### **Q: Who is eligible for the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive?**

**A:** PG&E customers, employees, contractors, retirees and their immediate family members living at the same address are eligible.

### **Q: What must I provide to the dealership to receive the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive?**

PG&E customers need to also bring a photo ID such as a driver's license and a recent copy of their PG&E bill. PG&E employees and contractors need to also bring a photo ID like a driver's license and either their 1.) PG&E employee badge, or 2.) a recent PG&E paystub. Retirees of PG&E need to provide solid proof of retirement status from PG&E such as a letter of retirement or a pension statement and a photo ID.

### **Q: Who else is eligible for the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive?**

**A:** Immediate family members of employees also qualify for this incentive if they reside at the same address as the PG&E, customer, employee, contractor or retiree. Proof of residency needs to be provided by the family member (such as a driver's license or another photo ID with the matching address).

### **Q: What vehicles are included in the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive?**

**A:** The purchase incentive applies to the new 2018 Nissan LEAF. No other models are eligible for this offer.

### **Q: Can I use the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive with models other than the LEAF?**

**A:** This incentive is only available for the purchase of a new 2018 Nissan LEAF.

### **Q: Can the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive be applied on a lease transaction?**

**A:** This incentive is only valid for purchase or finance of the 2018 Nissan LEAF.

### **Q: Can the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive be applied on a certified pre-owned or used Nissan?**

**A:** This incentive is only applicable to the purchase of a new 2018 Nissan LEAF.

### **Q: Is the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive applied at the time of transaction?**

**A:** Yes, the incentive is applied at the time of sale and will be deducted from the purchase price.

### **Q: Can the LEAF purchase incentive be combined with other retail promotions?**

**A:** This incentive is not combinable with other offers or retail promotions.

**Q: Is the LEAF purchase incentive only applicable to current inventory?**

**A:** This incentive can be applied to current inventory as well as orders placed through July 2, 2018

**Q: When does this program expire for PG&E customers, employees, contractors and retirees?**

**A:** The incentive is available through July 2, 2018.

**Q: Which Nissan dealerships are participating in this program?**

**A:** The offer is good at any authorized Nissan dealership located in PG&E's service area.

**Q: I just purchased a LEAF. Can I still get the \$3,000 LEAF purchase incentive for my car?**

**A:** Unfortunately, the purchase incentive is only applicable to new purchases made during the offer timeframe (April 24 – July 2, 2018).

**Q: Can eligible participants purchase more than one LEAF during the program?**

**A:** Yes, any eligible PG&E customer (both residential and commercial), employee, contractor, or retiree can purchase one or more 2018 Nissan LEAF and the \$3,000 purchase incentive will be applied to each vehicle.

**Q: How many miles can you drive the LEAF on a single charge?**

**A:** The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) estimates that the total range of the Nissan LEAF models is 151 miles.

**Q: Do I need special equipment to charge the LEAF?**

**A:** Every LEAF comes with an occasional use cable that can plug into a standard 120V outlet. However, there are charging solutions available that reduce the charging time of the vehicle. **Q: How can I find out where EV chargers are located?**

**A:** EV drivers can find lists of the thousands of public use charging stations available to them through websites such as the U.S Department of Energy's website at [www.afdc.energy.gov/fuels/electricity\\_locations.html](http://www.afdc.energy.gov/fuels/electricity_locations.html).

**Q: Is public charging free of charge?**

**A:** It depends. Some public chargers do not charge a fee for charging.

New Nissan LEAF owners will receive up to two years of complimentary charging at public fast chargers and Level 2 chargers at participating No Charge to Charge stations using the EZ-Charge card. See [www.ez-charge.com](http://www.ez-charge.com) for details.

**Q: How are these purchase incentives funded?**

**A:** The purchase incentive is funded solely through Nissan North America, Inc.

**Q: How do I receive a \$7,500 federal electric vehicle tax incentive?**

**A:** The federal tax credit is applied when filing for taxes and applied against income tax owed. Customers are encouraged to contact tax professionals to better understand how it applies to their personal tax situation.

**Q: What is PG&E's Clean Fuel Rebate and how do I receive it?**

**A:** The Clean Fuel Rebate is a one-time rebate of \$500 starting in January 2017. By participating in the statewide Low Carbon Fuel Standard program, PG&E generates credits for the clean electricity it provides to customers who charge their EVs at home. After selling these credits to regulated parties, PG&E returns the revenue to customers driving EVs through the new Clean Fuel Rebate.

PG&E residential customers with active electric service who own or lease a battery EV or plug-in hybrid EV can apply for the rebate. A PG&E account holder may also apply on behalf of a vehicle owner in their household or a tenant in a multi-unit dwelling with the vehicle owner's permission. Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) customers are also eligible to apply.
